

POULTRY INDUSTRY SUMMER 2008 INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Internship To Be Awarded By Lee Campbell Poultry & Egg Educational Foundation

Term: About 8 to 10 weeks during the summer of 2008 at a poultry company in the southern region of the United States.

Compensation: Usual intern salary is about \$500 per week.

Award: \$1,500 per intern awarded at beginning of internship (about early April 2008); up to an additional \$1,000 awarded when acceptable paper is written by intern and received by Foundation after completion of summer assignment (about mid-September 2008).

Award Criteria and Eligibility:

- Student, preferably junior or sophomore, in good standing who has demonstrated or expressed an interest in international business or agriculture marketing, especially poultry.
- Has completed a significant number of college courses in certain of the following courses: agriculture, marketing, business, international trade, foreign languages, or poultry science. International language ability and foreign cultural understanding are desired.
- Has an accumulated strong grade point average, preferably a "B" or better.
- Student willing to prepare an appropriate paper of his/her internship work activities or topic related to the international marketing of U.S. poultry products.

Application Process:

- Interested students must complete and submit the Foundation's internship application form (on backside of this page). Also, the student is encouraged to submit a brief essay (up to two pages) on his/her career objectives and how an internship in the poultry industry will be meaningful and worthwhile to the student.

Deadline:

- All applications must be received **no later than close-of-business Monday, March 17, 2008.** Notification of awards will be made about Monday, April 7, 2008.
