Serving an estimated 5.5 million students who regularly participate in campus recreational sports programs, NIRSA members are actively engaged in many areas of campus life: student leadership, development, and personnel management; wellness and fitness programs; intramural sports; sport clubs; recreation facility operations; outdoor recreation; informal recreation; and aquatic programs.

### **NIRSA Services Corporation (NSC)**

Formed in 1999, the NSC is a wholly-owned taxable subsidiary (C Corporation) of NIRSA, and supports the vision and mission of the association through enterprise. The NSC manages income from NIRSA sponsored and endorsed programs, developing assets through corporate partnerships and the sale of products with an advertising component. It oversees the National Campus Championship Series, the only campus non-varsity sports series that supports NIRSA’s dedication to fostering student development, commitment to the larger learning community, and emphasis on leadership and excellence.
