This two day backpacking event is a great introduction for beginners and also enjoyable as a weekend getaway for the seasoned backpacker in the Northwestern Connecticut foothills.

Day 1: After a 2 hour drive, we'll pick up the Appalachian Trail in Salisbury, CT and hike to our campsite. Depending on the time and weather we will hike the rest of the way to the summit of Bear Mountain, which provides views into Connecticut, Massachusetts, and New York. We will spend the rest of the evening resting and cooking dinner in camp.

Day 2: We continue with the backpacking tradition of waking up early, eating a hot breakfast and then hiking back to the van.
