### Experience Level

- Advanced- no experience needed, but some previous experience with backpacking will be helpful. Extremely physically demanding.
- All UConn Outdoors Trips require varying degrees of physical fitness. We are not qualified to evaluate your fitness level so you must do so on our own. If you are unsure about your physical condition consult with a physician before participating on any one of our trips.

### Trip Overview

If you are going to participate on any one of UConn Outdoors' trips during your stay at the university, this would be the one to spend your money on. An all-time favorite, this trip lets you explore the culture of the Havasuapi Tribe and the Supai village which is the only inhabited town inside the Grand Canyon. For three nights and four days we will be camping in between four of the worlds most photographed waterfalls, two of which were featured in MacGillivray Freeman's 3D IMAX film *Grand Canyon Adventure: River at Risk*. On top of all this you get to experience a unique desert ecosystem first hand, a feat that not many people get a chance to do in a lifetime.
