For this trip UConn Outdoors will be introducing you to the Fife Brook Dam section of the Deerfield River in Charlemont, MA. Here you will encounter up to class II rapids, a great level for beginners to practice their white water boating skills. Participants will be given instruction on the water where they will learn about paddling techniques, river features, and boater safety. Bring money for breakfast and lunch on the road.
